- NEVER agree to work being carried out from someone who knocks on your door uninvited
- Don't allow anyone to pressure you into having work done
- If you ask them to leave and they don't, contact the police on 999
- Use reputable traders who are members of the KCC Trading Standards approved trader scheme, run in partnership with <u>Checkatrade</u>
- Get a minimum of 3 quotes in writing








Doorstep crime is financial abuse
