## **QUEENS AVENUE, SNODLAND**

### **TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING**

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

**Kent County Council gives notice that Queens Avenue, Snodland will be closed to through traffic, on 25th November 2020 for up to 2 nights.**

**The road will be closed outside numbers 20-26.**

**The alternative route is via Waghorn Road, onto Queens Road.**

**It is planned that the road will be closed between 18:00 hrs and 05:00 hrs each night.**

**This closure is necessary to enable carriageway patching works to be carried out by Kent County Council.**

**This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 21 days.**
