TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Queens Avenue, Snodland will be closed to through traffic, on 25th November 2020 for up to 2 nights.

The road will be closed outside numbers 20-26.

The alternative route is via Waghorn Road, onto Queens Road.

It is planned that the road will be closed between 18:00 hrs and 05:00 hrs each night.

This closure is necessary to enable carriageway patching works to be carried out by Kent County Council.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 21 days.
