Beware of door-to-door fish sellers

KCC Trading Standards is warning residents across the County to beware of fish sellers trying to persuade householders to pay hundreds of pounds for fresh fish.

The sellers commonly use non-refrigerated vans so the buyers have no way of knowing if the fish is safe to eat.

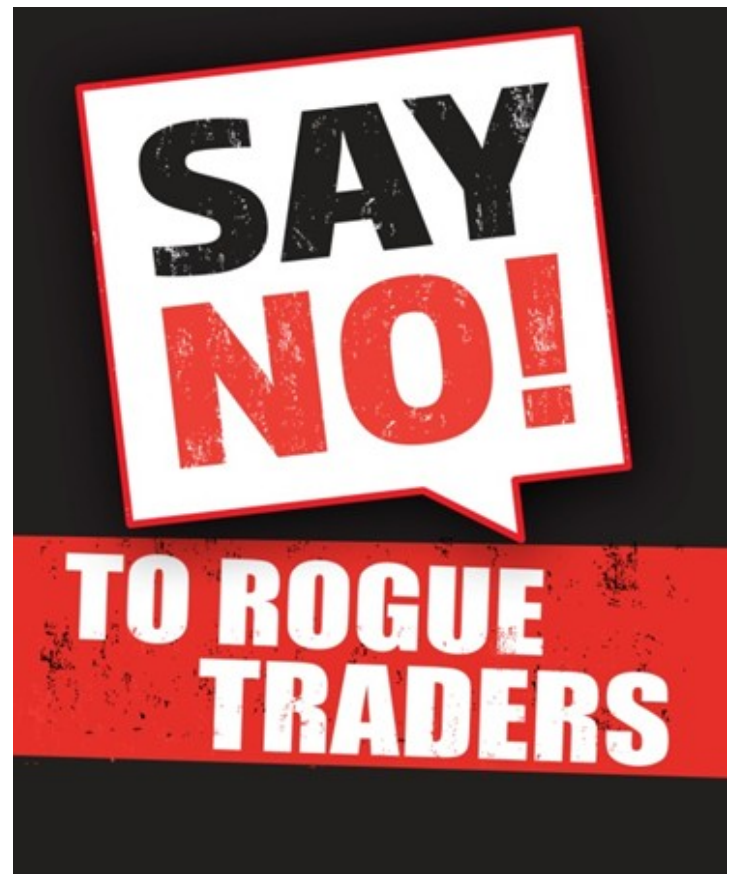
We recommend residents should always buy fresh fish from an established fishmonger.

Remember

- Don't buy from unsolicited callers at the door
- The fish will not be worth the price you pay
- There may be issues with labelling and quality of the fish

Your "cooling off" period when buying on the doorstep has changed and you now have **14 days** to cancel.
